



KIDS IN KARTS 2025 RULES

Ages 9-12 (as of Jan 1, 2026)

- *All participants must check in at the pit gate.
- *1 Parent only on the track infield to set the driver up!
- *A Minor Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement must be signed by parents or guardians at the beginning of the season or the participant's first race.
- *Any non-professional go-kart is permitted to race. Parents, select karts appropriate for your child's age, size, and skill level. We offer these events for the kids to have a chance to race on the track, let's keep it safe and fun!
- *No riding of go karts in the pit areas, except when officials call for Kids-N-Karts.
- *Kart and pit entry fees are not required. If you are staying in the stands, entry of the kart to the track can be made via the outside pit area.
- *Participants must wear closed-toed shoes and a helmet; a full-face helmet is preferred.

NO MONETARY AWARDS

*Any infractions to the rules will not receive any awards and will be asked to correct the infractions by the next event. All track and race directors have the right to make adjustments and decisions based on the safety of the participants. We will continue to do our best to make this a fun and fair event for everyone.
